

Ontario eConsult is a secure web-based tool hosted on the OTNhub.ca, that allows authorized senders timely access to specialist advice.

OntarioMD's Contextual Launch simplifies the submission of eConsult cases on the OTNhub for select OMD Certified EMRs

Sending an eConsult Case



EMR:

- Login to your eligible EMR & **open the applicable patient chart**/record (in context).
- **Select desired patient information** (ie. results, reports) from the patient chart and **save** as attachment.
- **Launch EHR** services, within your EMR. Select "OTN eConsult".
- **Login to ONEID** services, when prompted.



OTNhub:

- OTN eConsult launches with **draft case already in progress** (on the OTNhub).
- **Patient health information** (ie. first name, last name, date of birth, health card #) is **pulled** from EMR into eConsult form.
- **Select** desired specialty/specialist.
- Type eConsult question to specialist (if not included in attachments from EMR).
- **Manually upload** attachments to eConsult case.
- Click **Send**



Managing the Specialist Response

Senders (and their delegates) are notified, by email, once the specialist has provided an eConsult response.

- Login to OTNhub.ca. Review the case & complete, as applicable.
- Download PDF copy of completed eConsult or push through HRM@.

What do I Need to Use it?



- ONEID credentials
- OTNhub account
- An OMD-certified EMR, eligible for Contextual Launch services.
- Completed Client Information Form (CIF) & Ontario Health agreements.
- DHDR configuration set up (including OLIS/PKI Certification)

This feature can be used by delegates who have a ONEID login.

This feature is not available on the Champlain eConsult BASE™ platform.
