


Access the Viral Hepatitis Care Network Now on eConsult

eConsult is a secure web-based tool that allows physicians, nurse practitioners and midwives timely access to specialist advice and often eliminates the need for an in-person specialist visit.

The **Ontario eConsult Service**, accessed through the OTNhub.ca, offers **no-cost**, timely access to specialist advice to support the **diagnosis, management, and treatment of viral hepatitis**.



Clinicians can now submit eConsults to the **Viral Hepatitis Care Network** using **the Specific Provider or Group** option, providing province-wide access to specialists for consultation and **expert advice for the diagnosis, management, and treatment of hepatitis B (±D) and C**.

? What types of Viral Hepatitis questions are best suited for eConsult?

Hepatologists and infectious disease specialists can provide patient advice and recommendations assistance with:

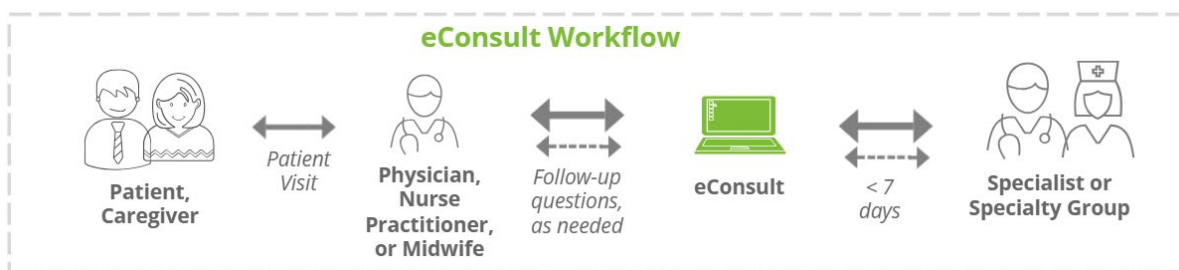
- Screening, diagnosis, assessment.
- Treatment planning, drug-drug interaction, antiviral selection.
- Complex care management, or linkage to in-person care.
- Post-treatment follow-up.

Cases can be sent using the "Specific Provider or Group" option on the OTNhub.

What information should I include in my eConsult?

To facilitate a thorough and timely consultation, please provide the following information:

- A clear question
- Past medical history
- Medications
- Allergies and reaction history, if relevant
 - Details of the reaction of concern the patient had, including timing and symptoms
